**VOTER REGISTRATION**

Address changes and new voter registrations are available at City Hall.

**UTILITY BILLS**

Water, sewer & trash bills are combined and billed monthly around the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month. It is payable at City Hall by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month or a penalty of 10% will be added. Due date is by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month, if payment is not made by the 20<sup>th</sup> of the month service will be discontinued and a fee of \$25.00 plus current balance will be necessary before service will be resumed. **NO SECOND NOTICE WILL BE GIVEN.** For your convenience, a 24-hour night drop is available to the north of the main door at city hall. Direct payment is also available, contact City Hall to enroll in this method of payment. Renters and mobile home owners are required to remit a \$100 deposit to begin water and trash service. This can be paid in 3 payments with initial deposit of \$50 required. The deposit will be used towards the final bill upon notification to City Hall that you are moving.

**PET LICENSING ORDINANCE:** Dog and cat owners are required to purchase city tags, renewable annually by February 1. Proof of rabies vaccination must be presented at the time of tag purchase. City ordinance states cats and dogs are not to run at large, that is, roam off the premises or property of the owner. Should an unlicensed dog or cat roaming at large be picked up, a fee plus boarding expenses shall be paid to City Hall prior to release of the animal. If a licensed animal roams from their owner's premises, every attempt will be made by city employees to contact the owner of said animal before resorting to impoundment at Concordia Veterinary Clinic.

**BURNING YARD FOLIAGE:** Burning of leaves and small limbs is permissible when on private property. No person may burn anything on city streets, on city curbing, or in alley right-of-ways. A waste dump site is available for **yard waste only**, contact City Hall for directions.

**TAX COLLECTOR:** City Collector is available in her office from December 1st to mid January. Tax payments can be brought in during regular City Hall hours, mailed or placed in the night drop throughout the year.

**BOARD OF ALDERMAN:** Regular Board of Alderman meetings are the 1st and 3rd Monday evenings at 7:00 P.M. at Community Center Room 203. The public is always welcome.

**MUNICIPAL COURT:** Court for the Concordia violations is held the 2nd Thursday of each month, 9:00 A.M. at Community Center Room 203.

Household refuse is picked up curbside two days a week, Monday or Friday, in the City of Concordia. If you are unsure of your specified day, please call City Hall at 463-2228. The fee for disposal is included in your monthly water bill. All trash must be placed at the curb by **7:00 a.m.** on the day of your neighborhood's collection. Use durable containers, plastic preferred. Do not use cardboard or paper grocery bags as they collapse when wet. If placed out overnight use animal-proof, lidded trash cans. Use of loose trash bags is discouraged overnight because of animals rummaging for food. Containers are not to exceed 35 gallon capacity or 75 pounds in weight.

**OCCASIONAL CLEAN-UP DUMPSTER AVAILABILITY:**

A variety of sizes of dumpsters are available for remodeling projects, basement and home clean-up projects, etc. Call Waste Corp for information.

**HOLIDAY SCHEDULES:** Trash services will be delayed by one weekday six times a year on the following holidays (unless the holiday falls on Saturday or Sunday): New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas Day. Please note these delays on your calendar.

**RECYCLING:** A recycling program sponsored by the City of Concordia and offered free of charge to all area residents is available on the third Saturday of each month. The location is behind the Community Center (802 S Gordon) from 9:00am -12:00pm. Unsorted items may be left prior to 9:00am the morning of recycling if necessary. Volunteers will deposit items in the appropriate compartments when they arrive. **YOU ARE ENCOURAGED TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THIS FREE COMMUNITY PROGRAM.**

**YARD WASTE BAGS:** Bio degradable "bio" bags are available for sale at City Hall. Leaves, twigs, garden plants, etc. may be placed in these bags and placed at curb on *Fridays only*. Call City Hall by 10 a.m. any given Friday if you intend to set out bags. The \$1 purchase price for each bag compensates the disposal company for removal and proper disposal of bags.



**WCA** has made available to the Concordia community rental of **POLY-CARTS**. By calling **WCA's** toll free number listed above you may request a cart for an annual fee of \$36. Carts are new and will be delivered to your residence. **WCA** will maintain the carts if mechanical failure of any sort occurs excluding customer misuse.
